The 42km Cape Town Cycle Tour is your chance to ride with friends, challenge rival schools to a cycling show-down, or race against classmates.

The 42km Cape Town Cycle Tour is the short and sweet addition to the world's largest timed cycle race. The 42km distance provides a platform for new cyclists, junior cyclists and those a little daunted by the main event's distance to experience the joy of cycling on closed roads.

All school-going riders aged 13 and older are invited to enter the 42km route. There will also be TWO racing categories: Boys Under-15 and Girls Under-17. (UCI rules apply and a CSA membership is required)

This year the Cape Town Cycle Tour has partnered with Western Cape Schools Cycling to bring you some added incentives to join our 42km pedal party.

We are giving away **2 Tacx FLUX S Smart Trainers valued at R13 999 each**. One will be awarded to the school with the most riders entered into the 42km Cape Town Cycle Tour.

Each rider competing for their school at the 42 km distance will earn points based on the Schools Cycling SA (SCSA) rules. Points allocated per position will be tallied up and the school with the most points accumulated after Cycle Tour will be awarded the second Tacx FLUX S Smart Trainer.

The 42km route will add to the 2023 Cycle Tour's celebration by providing an opportunity for more people to participate in one of South Africa's iconic mass-participation events.





THE ROUTE

Riders will start next to the Castle of Good Hope in Castle Street, after all the riders participating in the 109km Cape Town Cycle Tour have departed the start area on Sunday, 12 March 2023.

The 42km route will head southbound on Nelson Mandela Boulevard and the M3 until reaching Steenberg Road (where the traditional route peels off towards Muizenberg) before turning around to head home the way they came, finishing in Newmarket Street in the city centre.

This laidback out-and-back route is ideal for junior riders. Riders can expect the same great Cycle Tour organisation on the 42km route as well as a vibrant refreshment station atmosphere and legendary crowd support along the way.

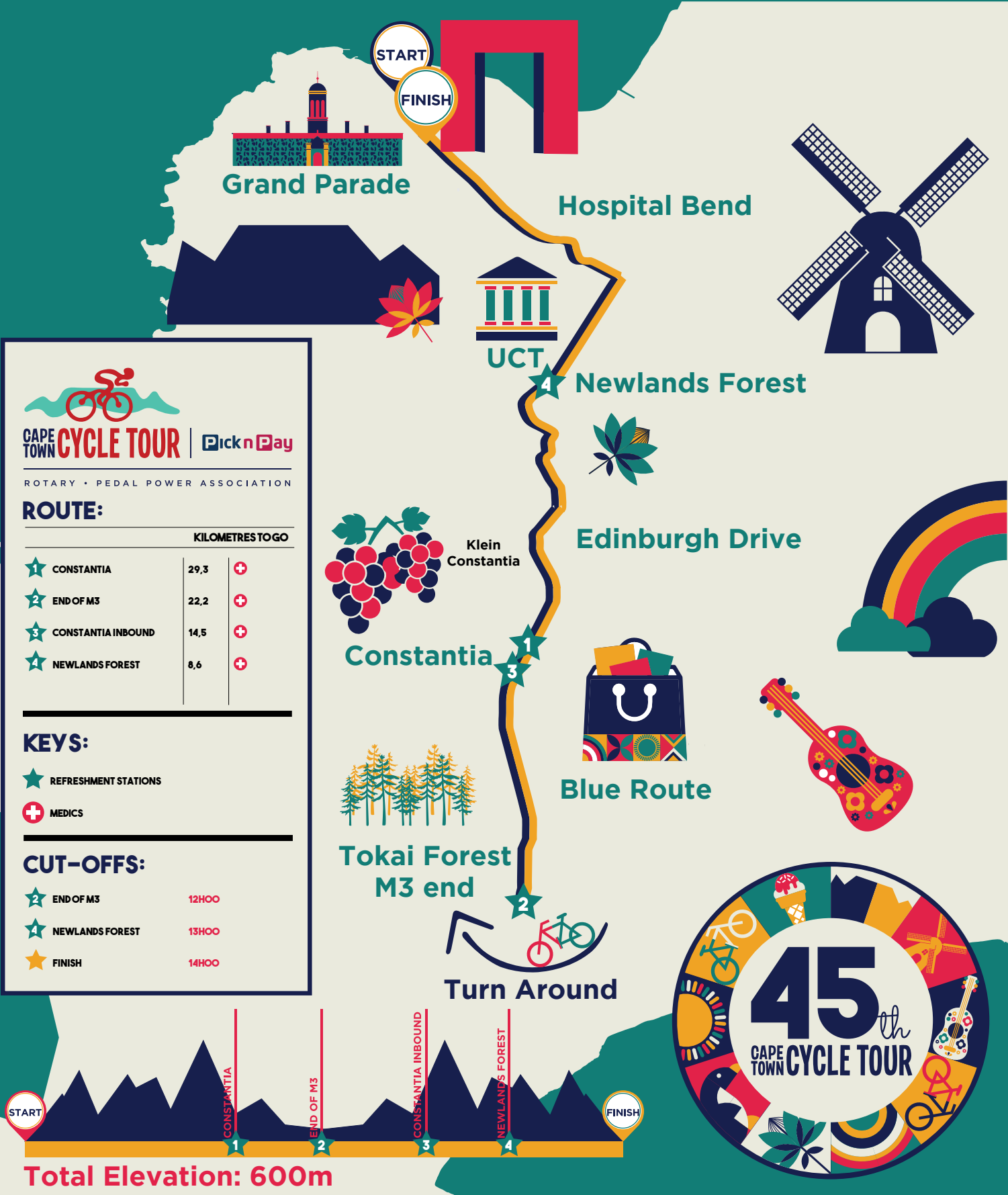
